Application Submission Checklist:

- 2018 Scholarship winners are ineligible for the 2019 year.
- Fillable application may be typed or neatly printed in black or blue ink and signed.
- Completed questions and essay material.
- One reference letter on letterhead from any of the following:
 - Teacher
 - Professor
 - Counselor
 - Advisor
 - Employer
 - Community Leader
- Copy of college or university acceptance letter is preferred. If you have not yet received a letter of acceptance, obtain a letter from your counselor on official letter-head stating the name of the college or university and the date application for admission was mailed.

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

A committee will review all applications and evaluate each application on a fair basis. Winning applicants will be contacted and posted on the website by July 19th, 2019.
